This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN 15651-2:2017. It supersedes BS EN 15651-2:2012, which is withdrawn.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee B/547, Sealants for building and construction.

The UK committee draws users' attention to the fact that although EN 15651-2:2017 supersedes EN 15651-2:2012, it is the 2012 standard that is cited in the Official Journal of the European Union under Regulation (EU) No 305/2011 *Construction products (CPD/CPR)*. The 2012 standard therefore continues to confer a presumption of conformity with the essential requirements of that regulation. At the time of publication, EN 15651-2:2017 is not cited. The UK committee recommends that users review the regulation's "Declaration of performance and CE marking" guide for application alongside Annex ZA of this standard to correctly understand their legal obligations.
