This standard has been prepared by Technical Committee CEN/TC 336 “Bituminous binders” (Secretariat: AFNOR, France).

The responsible German bodies involved in its preparation were the *Normenausschuss Materialprüfung* (Materials Testing Standards Committee) and the *Normenausschuss Bauwesen* (Building and Civil Engineering Standards Committee), Joint Committee NA 062-03-32 GA *Bitumen; Prüfverfahren und Anforderungen für die Bindemittel*.

Amendments

This standard differs from DIN EN 58:2004-10 as follows:

- a) the standard has been editorially revised;
- b) a new Subclause 8.1.1 “Necessary drawing off before sampling” has been included;
- c) in the German version, the term “Einwegdose” (“surface sampling can”) has been replaced by “Probenahmegefäß für Oberflächenproben”.
