Amendments

This standard differs from DIN EN 16908:2017-05 as follows:

- a) the standard has been updated to be in line with the latest version of EN 15804:2012+A2:2019. For this purpose,
 - 1) “EN 15804” or “EN 15804:2012+A1:2013” have been replaced by “EN 15804:2012+A2:2019” throughout the document;
 - 2) types of EPD with respect to life cycle stages covered have been rendered more precise in 5.2;
 - 3) the requirements for additional environmental information (see 5.4), the functional unit (see 6.3.2), the reference service life RSL (see 6.3.4), the data quality (see 6.3.8), the information on biogenic carbon content (see 6.4.4), the impact assessment (see 6.5), the indicators describing environmental impacts (see 7.2.3) have been added;
 - 4) the contents of Annex D have been moved to Annex F;
 - 5) Annex C, Annex D and Annex E have been included in accordance with EN 15804:2012+A2:2019;
- b) the standard has been editorially revised.
