Amendments

This standard differs from DIN EN 680:1994-02 as follows:

- a) The conditions for drying the samples have been defined.
- b) Before shrinkage measurement, samples shall now be stored in air to enable comparability of their moisture content.
- c) The total value of drying shrinkage has now been included.
