This document (EN 13285:2018) has been prepared by Technical Committee CEN/TC 227 “Road materials” (Secretariat: DIN, Germany).

The responsible German body involved in its preparation was *DIN-Normenausschuss Bauwesen* (DIN Standards Committee Building and Civil Engineering), Working Committee NA 005-07-15 AA “Aggregates (national mirror committee for CEN/TC 154, SC 1 to SC 5, WG 10, WG 11, and CEN/TC 227/WG 4)”.

Amendments

This standard differs from DIN EN 13285:2010-12 as follows:

- a) new categories for mixtures, grading and fines content as well as new designations have been added;
- b) the Scope has been amended taking into account new categories with an upper sieve size (*D*) of 5,6 mm to 90 mm;
- c) new terms and definitions have been added;
- d) an A-Deviation for Estonia has been added in the new Annex C. The former Annex C has been transferred to Clause 5.
