Amendments

This standard differs from DIN 16726:1986-12 as follows:

- a) The test procedure has been brought into line with that of EN 13956.
- b) The test temperature has been changed to ≥ 50 °C.
- c) Equations for calculation of the results have been introduced.
- d) A test report is now included.
- e) Annex A (informative) “Additional information” and Annex B (informative) “Calibration of apparatus” are now included.
