## **Amendments**

This standard differs from DIN EN 13877-1:2004-11 as follows:

- a) the standard has been editorially revised;
- b) in Subclause 4.3.2, the maximum spacing has been changed from  $\frac{1}{3}$  to  $\frac{1}{4}$ ;
- c) Table 1 has been extended to include strength classes S 3,7, S 4,3, S 4,6 und S 4,8 and footnotes <sup>a</sup> and <sup>b</sup> have been updated;
- d) in Table 2, footnotes <sup>a</sup> and <sup>b</sup> have been updated;
- e) in Table 3, NOTES 1 and 2 have been added.
