Amendments

This standard differs from DIN V 4141-13:1994-10 as follows:

- a) In this standard Group 2 guide bearings are specified regardless of the magnitude of the actions.
- b) The contents of this standard have been harmonized with the relevant provisions regarding CE marking and labelling of construction products.
- c) Specifications have been modified so that they are based solely on the semiprobabilistic approach using partial safety factors.
